Two Point Pelvic Belt – The Two Point Pelvic Belt improves the stabilization of the pelvis in a good seating position in the wheelchair or the seating unit. The belt tension can be adjusted easily according to the user's requirements.

Four Point Pelvic Belt – The Four Point Pelvic Belt offers improved resistance to movement and superior stability. The secondary attachment straps reduce the pelvic belt twisting. The belt holds the pelvis in a good position when the person has a lot of movement.

Foot strap – The Foot strap helps to stabilize the user's foot while allowing controlled movement. The strap improves comfort and tolerance for positioning.

Ankle strap – The Ankle strap helps to stabilize the user's ankle while allowing controlled movement. The strap improves comfort and tolerance for positioning.

Calf strap - DDO Universal Lower Leg/Calf Strap is a versatile strap that can be mounted on virtually any wheelchair to provide lower leg/calf support.
